## ACHIEVEMENTS SINCE FINAS 2024–2025

Achievement	What It Means
<b>National Agrifood System Investment Plan (NASIP) advanced</b>	4 of 8 lead consultants engaged; national & county consultations completed; AKADEMIYA2063 scenario modelling integrated. NASIP is Kenya's primary Kampala Declaration domestication vehicle.
<b>Draft Policy Framework for Sustainable Financing &amp; Subsidy Management</b>	Proposes Agricultural Development Fund (ADF) to mobilise public & private capital, reduce lending risk & expand affordable farmer finance. Developed with MoALD.
<b>AFTWG co-convened with Aceli Africa &amp; Kenya Bankers Association</b>	Agriculture Finance Taxonomy under development to standardise and track capital flows into Kenya's agrifood sector.
<b>CompensACTION fertiliser subsidy pilot</b>	Running in Nakuru, Kakamega & Bungoma with IFPRI. Baseline evidence generated on soil health, climate resilience & productivity.

<b>Agriculture Finance Taxonomy</b>	First-of-kind framework to track capital into Kenya's agrifood sector. Seeking FI and regulator adoption for transparency & evidence-based decisions.
